

Do You Have One of These Trucks on Your Farm or One Similar?



Check into getting a USDOT & UCR Number

Have you heard your neighbor say, "I don't really have a commercial truck, just a "Farm"-plated truck?"

For purposes of the UCR and the USDOT Number a **farm truck** is considered "**Commercial**" generally based on its size—if it's over 10,000 pounds GVWR or a combination vehicle (truck & trailer) with a GCWR over 10,000 pounds it's considered a commercial truck.

There is no fee associated with the USDOT Number. However there is a fee for the UCR Number.
