**Put in soybean Plot**

The Montgomery County Young Leaders put in their soybean plot on Carl and Lee Marten's Farm on Monday May 10<sup>th</sup>. It was certainly a different day than when they put in the corn plot in April. Monday was cloudy and windy with the temperature in the mid 50's as compared to bright and sunny with the temperature in the low 80's back in April.

The bean plot consists of 24 different varieties plus a check variety (Horizon) from the following companies: Horizon, Dynagro, Pioneer, Dairyland, Stine, LG, Becks, NK, Burrus, FS, Stone Seed and Bo-Jac.

The Young Leaders want to thank all the seed companies and dealers for donating seed and money to their project. We hope everyone will go by the corn and seed plots. The plots are located on the West Frontage Road just off of the junction of Interstate 55 and Illinois Route 127. The corn plot is located just south of Carl's house (Look for the Young Leaders Sign) and the bean plot is located one half of mile north at West Frontage Road and Goby Avenue.
